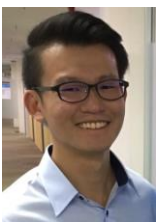

It is important that workplace stakeholders should have a clear understanding of their duties and responsibilities under the legislations so that relevant control measures can be taken to avoid / minimise risks of workplace accidents. The presentation will share investigation findings from concluded fatal accidents and lapses which could have been resolved.
