Workplace Accident – Who should be Responsible?

OVERVIEW

Post-workplace accident investigations often reveal that human errors are the main contributors of the accidents aside equipment failures. What does this tell us? Are workers not taking adequate and proper precautionary measures before work commencement? Is the management thinking that it is a waste of time and efforts to carry out regular inspections and take precautionary measures to ensure the workplace is safe for all?

In a recent press report, a company was prosecuted and fined \$0.23mil by the MOM for failing to ensure a work equipment was maintained and safe to use for accessing work at heights - two workers lost their lives as a result of poor equipment maintenance.

It is important that workplace stakeholders should have a clear understanding of their duties and responsibilities under the legislations and common law so that relevant control measures can be taken to avoid/minimise risks of workplace accidents.

OBJECTIVE

This course gives an overview of the common causes of workplace accidents and the stake holders' duties and responsibilities under the respective legislations and common law. Court case judgments are used to illustrate the requirements of the stakeholders. Practical control measures to avoid/minimise risks of workplace accidents are covered.
