### **OVERVIEW**

In construction industry where people have to work together and cooperate there is a possibility for disputes to arise, caused by a combination of uncertainty, contractual problems, and behaviour factors. A typical construction project usually comprises transactions with high uncertainty and complexity, which is impossible to resolve every detail and foresee every contingency at the outset. As a result, disputes often arise in situations that are not clearly addressed by the contracts. Today, most construction contracts contain some form of Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) to resolve disputes without going into the classic courtroom setting, and the most common form of ADR is arbitration. While arbitration is a valuable contract dispute resolution method, in some complicated cases; however, the time taken to settle the disputes may be comparable to that of litigation and cost. In this respect, mediation is one ADR process where the disputants could maintain control of the process, the costs and the outcome. It is gaining popularity in Singapore.

#### **OBJECTIVE**

This one-day course gives an overview of mediation process in resolving construction disputes. Special emphasis will be on the proposed enactment of Mediation Bill, aimed to strengthen the framework for enforcement of mediated settlements conducted in Singapore. The enhanced legislative framework is expected to provide greater certainty and clarity for commercial parties who opt to conduct their mediation in Singapore.
