OVERVIEW

It was reported by BCA in its news release in Jan 2014 that contracts for the built environment industry, driven by strong public housing demand and anticipated higher construction demand for institutional developments and major infrastructure projects, for 2015 and 2016, the projected average construction demand could be sustained at between \$25–34 billion per annum 60% of the total demand is forecasted to come from building projects while the remaining 40% is expected to come from civil engineering projects

On 28 May 14, PM Lee indicated in parliament that more than \$2 billion of public construction projects would be deferred in order to spread out labour demand, as the Government continues to slow the inflow of foreign workers. However, despite the deferment, the scale of the construction projects remains substantial which warrants all construction professionals to have a clear understand of key processes in the administering and managing of construction projects so as to complete the various works smoothly, on time and within budget

OBJECTIVE

This is the follow-up course of “Construction Projects: Laws and Pre-Award Administration”. This one-day course gives an overview of the types of construction contract and the standard conditions of design and build construction contract. The participants will also learn about the post-award activities and management of disputes and construction safety and health matters. These are very important, as mis-management could lead to project delay, cost overrun and legal proceedings.
